

Weekend road chaos expected

MOTORISTS have been warned to drive carefully as millions hit Spain's roads during this week's national holidays.

Spain's Directorate General of Traffic has estimated that around 6.7 million vehicles will clog its road network over the weekend, and has been warning drivers to exercise caution since Tuesday, especially in and around cities and the coast.

Record swoop

ANTI-DRUGS police have claimed that $a \in 210$ million, six tonne cocaine haul seized in Algeciras is the largest this century.

Investigators swooped on a Colombian container ship and found the drugs hidden in a shipment of bananas destined for Barcelona.

Three people including one Spaniard, one Honduran and one Portuguese have been remanded in custody in connection with the raid.

€3.4bn takeover New owner for Costa project

The firm behind Birmingham's Bullring centre has agreed to buy the company backing the Costa del Sol's most ambitious shopping project.

And the \in 3.4 billion deal will see the creation of Britain's biggest property business worth around \in 23 billion.

It comes as Hammerson, which also owns London's Brentford Cross centre, made the eye-watering offer to acquire rival developer Intu, the company behind $a \in 650$ million scheme to build what will be Andalucia's biggest shopping complex in Torremolinos.

The takeover will see Insu's portfolio, including Manchester's Trafford Centre and the Metrocentre in Gateshead, retain the Hammerson name. Hammerson chief executive, David Atkins, said: "Strategically it's

about acquiring more of the best quality shopping centres in the UK, but also it gives us a new market in Spain."

The 600,000 square-metre complex will include shops, restaurants, an artificial lake and a dry ski slope, and is expected to create around 4,500 jobs. Af-

ter years of delays there has been significant progress in recent months, but the brakes have again been applied after the Junta de Andalucia on Tuesday approved Torremolinos' PGOU Town Planning proposal, except for the plot where the centre is to be built.

Located adjacent to the town's Aqua Park, the regional authority is seeking answers to concerns over increased traffic at the site.

But Insu's director in Spain, Salvador Arenere, said that he hopes plans will be approved "within a matter of weeks."

A HIGH RANKING mafia leader has been held on the Costa del Sol.

The 69-year-old mobster, named as Cosimo Piscioneri, was remanded in custody on an international warrant at a pizzeria he owns in holiday hotspot Benalmadena.

It comes after a five year drug trafficking probe by police in Italy, with 12 other leaders of the gang arrested in the southern region of Calabria.

All belong to the notorious Ndragheta clan and are suspected of smuggling large quantities of hashish to Turin, Italy, in false-bottomed lorries and rental cars, police said in a statement.

The operation has been headed by CP since 2014, when the two original leaders, including his brother Rocco, were also arrested in Spain.

He regularly visited them in prison, was responsible for the collection and distribution of money connected to the operation, and owned a series of firearms.

A Madrid judge has remanded him in custody while authorities prepare to extradite him to Italy, where he reportedly faces a 24-year jail sentence.

Animal killer jailed

THE ex-animal shelter boss found guilty of killing thousands of animals is behind bars.

It comes after Carmen Marin, former manager at Torremolinos' municipal animal pound, failed in a final appeal after claiming she suffers from psychological issues.

But the medical documents submitted by her legal team continue to be probed by Malaga's Criminal Court after the prosecutor initially ruled that 'the defendant can serve the prison sentence because the alleged pathologies do not endanger her life.'

Marin voluntarily entered the Victoria Kent Social Insertion Centre in Madrid before being transferred to a prison in the Spanish capital.

The former president was in 2016 found guilty of slaughtering at least 2,183 animals between 2008 and 2010.

She used small doses of a euthanasia product to kill the victims cheaply, so they died a slow, painful death.

She will serve three years and nine months in jail for forgery and animal abuse.

Rail probe launched

THE judge handling the investigation into the Malaga-Sevilla train that went off the rails last Wednesday asked to see reports revealing how fast it was travelling and how the extreme weather conditions impacted the event. At least 37 passengers were injured in the accident, two seriously.

POLICE have detained a 28-year-old accused of stabbing a German man in the chest in Guadalmar after the two allegedly got in a heated argument. Police came upon the 20-yearold German clutching his bleeding chest, and succeeded in locating the knife-wielding attacker in close proximity.

THE decision over whether to extradite Carlos Fernandez has been delayed indefinitely by an Argentine court after Spanish authorities submitted four more charges against him. The ex-Marbella councillor is wanted for multiple crimes, including bribery, misuse of public funds, and his involvement in the 'Malaya' scandal.

ELEVEN youths have been held in Torremolinos for allegedly throwing firecrackers and stones at moving trains as they passed through La Colina station. Police swooped to find the gang hidden in nearby bushes after receiving a complaint from rail company ADIF, who claim that it is a regular occurence.

Real twisters for the tongue

SPAIN is a mixing pot of major languages, especially as European, Arabic and Asian residents settle in their own communities.

The country's history is littered with discarded sub-languages and the politics of retaining dialects that are spoken by so few people.

Today, virtually all native Spaniards speak Castilian, the language foreigners somewhat simplistically refer to as 'Spanish.'

Under General Franco's fascist dictatorship, regional variations were marginalised and even banned in public, reinforcing Castilian dominance.

Minority sign language dialects are also still in use in the Canary Islands, Basque Country, Galicia and eastern Andalucia, but are much closer to the national version, which boasts an estimated 100,000 users.





Clean slate? Drinking water used on roads

FUENGIROLA Town Hall have been using drinking water to clean the city's streets.

Despite concerns about drought in the region, the local authority has been using high-power spray hose pipes on concrete streets.

One resident, 69-year-old Ron Gom-

bault, said: "I think thousands of litres of good water were wasted on an already reasonably clean boulevard."

Mr Gombault also claims the cleaning began at 5.30am one morning and was noisy.

Noting that it rained significantly the next day, he added that he believed "very much work and water" was wasted on cleaning "kilometres" of the Paseo Maritimo.

Last week, one street cleaner con-

firmed to a *Euro Weekly News* journalist that the water being used to clean an area of pavement was drinkable.

The town hall have been contacted for comment by *Euro Weekly News* but had not replied at the time of going to print.

There have long been concerns about the availability of water in the region, and local experts have warned that action must be taken to avoid water shortages.

A word of warning

A BRITISH expatriate has warned of a potential scam on the Costa del Sol.

The Fuengirola resident, who did not wish to be named, told the *Euro Weekly News* that a man claiming to be an electrician rang her doorbell and asked if she had received a letter.

But when she said no, the man who was 'in his mid-to-late 20's' pushed his way inside and asked to see her kitchen.

On his way he 'was looking around and not paying attention to the kitchen at all,' leading the by now frightened Briton to usher him outside.

At the door, she spotted that 'an accomplice' was waiting for him on the stairs.

She described the man as 'Spanish but with good English, very polite and smart, wearing jeans and carrying a clipboard.'

It comes as local Spanish media reported that an identical con in Malaga City this week saw a 90year-old woman relieved of \in 35,000 in cash.



OUR VIEW Spain is losing Big Mac battle

THE crowning of San Sebastian as the world's top food city is another feather in the cap for Spanish gastronomy.

But as the country's culinary heritage continues to attract international acclaim, Spain must be careful to retain its traditional mealtime values.

An upswing in demand for Iberian ham from China has seen demand outstrip supply, while the famed Mediterranean diet increasingly appears more medical advice than lifestyle choice.

And as the price of ham, olive oil and other delicacies rockets, working class Spanish families are increasingly turning to the same packaged, cost-effective fare that has sparked an obesity crisis across the globe.

A recent report by two international think tanks concluded that the country is moving away from the Mediterranean diet, as the relentless rise of convenience and fast food sparks a profound cultural shift.

The World Health Organisation says that Spain is one of the top European countries for obese children, while the proportion of overweight adults has increased from below 8 per cent in 1987 to 16 per cent today.

The Mediterranean diet should include large amounts of fruit, vegetables, pulses, whole grains and olive oil, but importantly, none of this comes in a box.

Nearly 600 migrants could be in Archidona prison

THE number of Algerian migrants placed in an Archidona prison could be as high as 570, according to different organisations.

Malaga Acoge say children could also be among the group, who remain in the facility despite widespread outrage about their treatment.

Opposition parties, charities and non-governmental organisations have spoken out about the situation, with some labelling it illegal.

A solidarity platform - comprised of around 20 social entities - again denounced the 'deficient conditions' at the prison earlier this week.

Gabriel Ruiz, a spokesman for the platform, claimed that until a visit from politicians last Friday, migrants remained in the same clothes for 12 days and that the heating was not in operation.

Speaking on Monday, he also suggested that some of the group had not been given access to phones or their belongings, and that only one interpreter and doctor was available.

The Ministry of the Interior have not responded to multiple requests for a comment. In a statement reported by *Euro Weekly*

News last week, the ministry said: "The exceptional use of the Archidona centre has been motivated by an exceptional situation of irregular immigrants arriving on the Levante coast, who were unable to stay in the other Foreigners' Internment Centres."

The government have shown little sign of changing course since mid-November, when

the migrants were placed in the facility. The Secretary of State for Security, Jose Antonio Nieto has said the government would 'try' not to hold the migrants for longer than 60 days.

Thousands of refugees have attempted to cross the Mediterranean Sea in an attempt to reach Europe in recent months.

A loving farewell

BRAVE brain cancer fighter, Leo the Lion may have gone, but he will never be forgotten.

Hundreds of friends, family and supporters of the inspirational fouryear-old gathered on Palomares beach in Almeria to pay tribute in a moving ceremony which saw 250 helium-filled balloons - many carrying hand-written messages - released into the sky.

The Euro Weekly News team performed a simultaneous release of balloons outside their head office on the Costa del Sol, as did campaign support groups and individuals in other parts of Spain, the UK and beyond.

An invitation-only funeral and cremation saw family and close friends pay their own respects on Tuesday, after many sent flowers or paid a visit to Leo as he lay in the chapel of rest over the weekend.

A hearse carried him around Palomares prior to the service, allowing

people to pay their respects and friends to wave goodbye.

In the UK, thousands of Manchester City supporters honoured Leo with a minute's applause during their home Premier League match against West Ham last Sunday.

Days short of his fifth birthday,

which would have been yesterday (Wednesday) the courageous fouryear-old passed away peacefully in his mother Karen's arms last Friday as dad Jorge and sister Sofia stood by.

His last words were, to Sofia, a very clear "I love you."

On September 2, 2015 Leo was diag-

nosed with a rare form of brain cancer.

Since then he underwent surgery at Alder Hey Children's Hospital in the UK and, thanks to a fund launched late last year, which the Euro Weekly News supported, travelled to Oklahoma in the United States for cutting-edge proton beam therapy.

But sadly, it was all in vain.

Police clock watch scam

INVESTIGATORS in Marbella have held a 31-year-old Spanish thief for pretending to be a crime victim.

The accused contacted police to claim that the locks on his delivery van had been forced and $\in 6,170$ worth

of watches stolen.

However, a probe revealed that that the incident did not happen, with the driver having taken the merchandise - destined for a popular Puerto Banus boutique - himself.

'Messi of hashish' arrested

THE leader of one of the largest drug trafficking gangs in Spain has been arrested in a joint operation by Spain's National Police and Guardia Civil. Abdellah El Haj had escaped

to Morocco in May after 19 of his gang were arrested.

The Moroccan heads one of the largest marihuana trafficking operations in Spain that operates through the Strait of Gibraltar. He has now been detained in Campo de Gibraltar by Guardia Civil officers from Algeciras.

Last May, the National Police and the Guardia Civil detained 19 people, all of them now in prison, for possession of 13 tonnes of hashish. Four firearms were also recovered. Abdellah, however, had a getaway car parked nearby and managed to escape to Morocco.

The drug trafficker is known to police as the 'Messi of hashish' for his frequent social media posts in which he wears the shirt of the Argentine football player.

Despite the fact that he has a history of fleeing, following his arrest, the alleged drug dealer was released the day after his arrest by the courts on $\in 100.000$ bail.

He has also had to surrender his passport and report to the court on a daily basis.



Protesters call for independence

to have attended the march through Malaga City.

THOUSANDS of left-wing protesters have marched through Malaga City to remember a dead protester and call for Andalucian independence.

The annual march takes place in early December in memory of Javier Verdejo, a communist protester who was shot dead by police during an independence march in 1976.

His shooting came in the transition period following the end of General Franco's dictatorship and caused outrage.

The official account of his death cleared police of any wrongdoing.

Waving Andalucian flags and marching en masse, organisers demanded bread, work and liberty while calling for Andalucia to become independent from Spanish rule.

Alonso Martinez, a 32-yearold protester, said: "I don't support Andalucian independence but I am a revolutionary.

"It's a good place to meet people and exchange ideas."

The demonstration follows tensions over Cataluñian independence.

In October, Catalans voted heavily in favour of separation from Spain, in an illegal referendum overshadowed by police violence.

Other regions of Spain, including the Basque Country, Valencia and Galicia, also have strong independence movements.

THE Spanish Confederation of Labour Unions has revealed that Malaga Province has one of the lowest number of hospital beds per inhabitant in the whole of Europe, with only 15 beds per 10,000 inhabitants.

OFFICIALS in Andalucia have announced plans to become a go-to destination for the LGBTQIA community.

Around 10 per cent of visitors to the region are LGBTQIA, according to data from the World Tourism Organisation.

The first LGBTQIA International Tourism Meeting was held in Torremolinos, which is already a hotspot for LGBTQIA tourists, and was attended by around a hundred tour operators from numerous countries.

The event was chaired by Francisco Javier Fernandez, the Andalucian Minister of Tourism, who revealed the average amount spent by the community - around \in 113 per day - and said he wants the community to feel at home in the province.

Spain as a whole has also seen a rise in LGBTQIA tourism, with a 28 per cent increase in visitors in the last year alone.

The mayor of Torremolinos, Jose Ortiz, described Torremolinos as an 'open city' which has pioneered the way for LGBTQIA tourism since the 1960's when the first gay pub opened there.

This meeting consisted of presentations and workshops about how to best promote the region's accommodation, cultural sites, beaches, gastronomy and leisure activities to make them attractive for LGBTQIA visitors.

MIJAS Town Hall has denied that a hosepipe ban is in place. Some residents have suggested that water use is being restricted in the area. One reader contacted Euro Weekly News to say: "I am told hosepipe ban now in place locally ... and certainly the gym run by the town hall in La Cala is telling users that 'you can't shower here.'

But a council official stated that "there is no such hosepipe ban."

They went on to suggest that incidents at the gym "seem to be a misunderstanding."

The volume of water in Mijas aquifers has been decreasing each year due to drought and increased consumption, leading experts to warn that action needs to be taken. The head of a water company warned last week that levels were "worrisome," warning that water supplies in Mijas, Torremolinos and Benalmadena could be affected.

Top of the tree

TWO Malaga hospitals have been named among Spain's best.

Both the Carlos Haya and the Quironsalud Malaga were named on the fourth edition of the Health Reputation Monitor (MRS) lists, highlighting the best private and public hospitals in the country. The lists are compiled by Merco, a corporate reputation managerial monitor, alongside a reported 3,200 experts in the field, including doctors, nurses, health associations, patients, managers and health journalists.

Seventy-five hospitals appear in the list of the best public hospitals in Spain, while the private list is reduced to 25.

Despite continuing to feature on the separate lists, both Malaga hospitals fell in their overall standing compared to last year.

In the public list, the Carlos Haya features at 22nd position, falling six places after it was rated 16th in the 2016 survey, while on the private list, the Quironsalud Malaga fell from 8th position to 10th.

The list of the top 10 public hospitals is dominated by clinics based in Madrid and Barcelona.

SPAIN is leading an initiative to take action against plastic pollution affecting sea creatures.

According to the country's embassy in London, they are seeking global approval to deal with plastic litter's impact on marine life. Worldwide, plastic in the ocean is leading to the deaths of sea creatures who ingest tiny particles of the material. Scientists believe that plastic

is now so widespread in the oceans that it will remain in the food chain for decades and could affect human health.

Plastics also often trap animals and impact tourist hotspots.

Spanish delegates have spoken at an ongoing International

Maritime Organisation (IMO) summit, which focuses on climate change and sustainability.

The embassy said Spain was leading an IMO initiative against marine plastic pollution and that they were 'seeking enhanced Assembly's commitment' on plastic marine litter.

In October, Spain became the 32nd country to sign up to the UN Clean Seas campaign, which aims to 'turn the tide on plastic.' Plastic use continues to grow dramatically, with some eight million tonnes being discarded into the oceans each year, according to the UN.

Shoot for the stars

STARGAZERS will be treated to one of the most impressive meteor showers of the year next week.

The Geminids are set to peak on next Wednesday night and the morning of Thursday December 14.

Viewers' experiences will vary depending on atmospherics, but southern Spain should see the spectacle comparatively clearly because it has less light pollution than many other areas.

Depending on weather conditions, space enthusiasts will be able to view up to 120 meteors per hour, according to space.com.

As the name suggests, the shooting stars - which are visible worldwide for a number of days - appear to come

from the Gemini constellation.

The shower is thought to be nearly 200 years old and is one of the most famous in the astrological calendar.

It has been getting stronger since because of Jupiter's gravity pulling the shower closer to earth. Experts advise that binoculars are not necessary but suggest staying away from artificial light and allowing 20-30 minutes for the human eye to adjust to the dark.

There is thought to be no danger of any meteors reaching the Earth's surface.

Meanwhile, last week a 'supermoon' was visible over parts of Spain. Two more are expected next year, in January in February.

Spain is home to 'world's best city'

ACCORDING to a major study commissioned by a British catering service Spain is top of the list of the world's top 100 cities for food. San Sebastian, in the north of the country, led the rest of the world in the survev for Caterwings.

Rajoy tells May: Brexit talks will begin soon

THE prime ministers of Britain and Spain have met in Downing Street for Brexit talks.

Theresa May and Mariano Rajoy discussed the next phase of negotiations during a lunch meeting on Tuesday, which also covered citizens' rights, Gibraltar and the Catalan referendum. Rajoy told May that he was "absolutely convinced" the next phase of Brexit talks would begin shortly, despite Monday's deadlock over the Irish border.

Writing in the *Guardian* ahead of the meeting, Rajoy said the two countries' histories were "inextricably intertwined, and will continue to be so."

He added: "Britain can count on Spain's loyal and sincere friendship."

May said: "I want to reiterate my support for

Prime Minister Rajoy on Cataluña. It is important that the rule of law is upheld and that the Spanish constitution is respected."

Thanking the UK for backing the Spanish government during the Catalan referendum, Rajoy wrote that Brexit would not break the countries' 'friendship'. Though he emphasised the importance of trade between the two countries, he later tweeted that 'the main priority for Spain is and will continue to be the preservation of the rights and interests of citizens.'

His article did not mention Gibraltar, which has been a source of some tension between the two nations.

A sparkling wine with Denominación de Origen (DO) status from Cataluña, cava can be produced throughout Spain, though about 95 per cent is from Penedes (near Barcelona) with Codorníu and Freixenet the major and best known among about 200 manufacturers.

Cava in Catalan means 'cellar' with the name officially adopted in 1970 to distinguish it from French Champagne, though only wines produced in the champenoise traditional method may be labelled cava.

The primary grape is Macabeu with faint floral aromatics and slightly bitter finish; Xarel·lo has stronger floral and fruity aromas while Paralleda has high acidity and citrus flavours, creating a balanced fruity sparkling drink closer to Champagne than Prosecco.

Produced in varying lev-

els of sweetness, the driest cava is brut nature, progressing through brut, brut reserve, seco, semiseco to

dulce which is the sweetest. Dating back as early as 1851, cava can be white (blanc) or rosé (rosat), which is produced by adding small quantities of red wines: Cabernet Sauvignon, Garnacha or Monastrell.

Though some regard cava as an aperitif or a drink served for a toast, in fact it is highly versatile when




food pairing as it can be light and refreshing all the way up to fullbodied.

Its acidity and effervescence will compliment

a whole range of foods including poultry, cured and smoked meats, fish and seafood in addition to light desserts and spicy Asian dishes.

Cava prices range from a few euros per bottle to € 30 for a Gran Reserva, though in all cases I do not believe you will be disappointed. Happy tasting.

Winter cold has arrived, time to make your warm fireside sanctuary

GRAEME TYRRELL

IF you are fortunate enough to have a well constructed fireplace or wood burning heater, it is a wonderful asset for keeping warm during the short days and long nights of winter.

Gardeners have an advantage for having a supply of wood to burn from their own garden while improving the health of their garden. It is the right time to prune deciduous trees and shrubs in winter and this can be a great source of kindling and logs for your fire.

The Mediterranean trees that provide the best firewood are olives, almond, carob and to a lesser extent pine. They are readily available from the regular pruning on farmland and larger gardens but if you have some of these trees in your garden you will have ready access to your own supply.

An enclosed fireplace that prevents sparks from flying out makes the range of wood that can be burned extended. Wood such as pine and cypress can spit out sparks profusely, but burn well with plenty of heat if well managed.

Many other trees and shrubs can also be used

such as citrus, mulberry, holm oak, hackberry, grape vine branches and they will give various amounts of heat and lengths of time to burn according to the characteristics of the wood.

It is a long term process to prepare firewood as living wood pruned off the trees is better left a year to dry out before burning to reduce their moisture level. Dead wood pruned off the trees can be used straight away.

It is easiest to cut logs to size when still green as the saw will have less difficulty to cut through them as the moisture acts as a lubricant for the saw. The opposite is true for splitting wood as the drying process makes sawn logs shrink and crack naturally making split larger logs much easier

I find it easiest to prune with creating firewood in mind so I cut the branches to fireplace size as I prune. This makes it easier to transport the prepared logs and branches straight to the wood shed ready made.

Even with all the trees I have, I still need to buy wood to keep the fireplace burning 24/7 during the coldest months but I appreciate that the cost of firewood is usually justified when you understand the time it takes for trees to grow and the work to prepare, store and transport it for the wonder of a living fire to keep warm.

The ash from a fireplace can also be a benefit for the garden as a natural soil improvement. It should not be used in excess as it is very alkaline and is best used in combination with plenty of compost and manures that are more acidic to keep the soil ph balance neutral when adding the ash.

It is great for improving the soil texture which makes it easier to dig and provides loads of carbon which is important for storing nutrition from the other organic fertiliser added to the garden.

DO YOU dream of a perfect Christmas tree?

You know, the kind you see in shop windows, complete with tasteful colour palettes, perfectly spaced baubles and discreet lighting?

If the perfect tree has so far eluded you, you are in luck because House and Garden has shared its advice for decorating your tree like an editor.

Deputy decoration editor Ruth Sleightholme says there are five steps to creating a fairy tale Christmas tree, beginning with choosing the right fairy lights. She explains, "a Christmas tree can appear as a bit of a dark hulk without them. Always choose 'warm white' lights rather than colder tones, these are so much cosier and less brash."

advises Next, she using two sets which you can connect to each other to save the hassle of working with two sets, as well as pushing lights deep into the tree's branches. hiding any cables and creating a subtle twinkling effect.

Sleightholme says adding foliage such as pale Eucalyptus or Ruscus will add visual depth as well as variety. She advises, "simply stuff the boughs of foliage into the tree, making it appear fuller and more generous."

On top of this, the editor recommends using simple decorations, choosing two or three designs.

Ruth says your tree will have the most impact if "these elements contrast," such as using red and gold.

Lastly, she suggests keeping the size of your decorations to scale with your tree, adding "you never need as many as you think for an impactful look."

If you have a tiny tree, she says, "miniature decorations would look adorable."



Mini's electric marvel LA's British invasion

MINI brought its new Electric Concept to the Los Angeles Auto Show this week. It was the US debut for the British brand's latest creation.

Alongside the Electric Concept, Mini also wooed the American audience with 10 different models. Its Ice Blue Edition is designed exclusively for the American market and was paraded alongside the Mini Hardtop 4 and new Mini Convertible.

But Mini's venture into the emerging electric market was the most anticipated moment of the show. The Electric Concept is

powered by a lithium-ion battery, emits zero emissions and is more mobile than the original, while maintaining the distinctive Mini look.

Large scale production of the Mini Electric is slated for early 2019, exactly 60 years after the classic Mini invaded British streets.

It will be released alongside hybrid plug-in model, the Mini Cooper S E Countryman ALL4. The hybrid Countryman can reach a top speed of 78mph on the electric motor alone. It switches into combustion mode when high performance is needed. Speeds of up to 189mph are possible.

Another British brand has raised eyebrows at the LA Convention Centre. Land Rover has released what has been described as the most luxurious Range Rover in history. The SV Autobiography is an SUV with a luxury interior including power-close door, a hot stone massage option, bountiful leg space, 4G wifi, wine bottle holders, and a fridge.

There is a plug-in hybrid version and a 4.4 litre SDV8 turbocharged diesel option. Prices start at around £170,000 (\in 193,000). The SV Autobiography comes with its own signature watch for an extra \in 5,000.



The car has a smaller than usual steering wheel which looks and feels a little odd but you quickly get used to it. My test model was a topspec GT Line model with a 2.0 litre 148 hp diesel engine and six-speed manual transmission.

A BENTLEY once owned by Sir Elton John is up for auction. The S1 Continental Sport Saloon is being offered up to wealthy collectors at the Bonhams Bond Street sale.

Rocket Man bought the car in 1976, when it was almost 20 years old. He spent a small fortune renovating the car he described as 'the most beautiful ever designed.'

The 1957 Saloon was soon equipped with air con, power steering and a state-ofthe-art stereo system. In the early 2000s he sold it to businessman Sir Alan Sugar at a Christie's sale. Sugar paid more than €200,000 for the car. Later he famously remarked: "Elton John stitched me up with this Bentley. I bought it at auction, on the phone. Bid against myself I reckon."

Sugar made a loss on the car when he sold it six years later. But in 2017 it is expected to fetch between $\leq 450,000$ and $\leq 550,000$ as the classic car market enjoys a lucrative revival.



Real Madrid president Florentino Perez remains keen to lure de Gea, 26, to the Bernabeu after the 2018 World Cup, following a proposed move collapsed in 2015.

De Gea, settled at Old Trafford, joined Manchester United from Atletico Madrid in 2011, and earns £200,000 a week, having signed a new deal.

If De Gea - whose current contract with United ends in 2019 - departs. Red's boss Jose Mourinho has been linked with a move for Barcelona's Marc Andre Ter-Stegen.

Ter-Stegen, who has a €160 million release clause in his contract, took the jersey of Claudio Bravo at the Nou Camp, following his departure to Manchester City in 2016.

The opening game of the World Cup features hosts Russia against Saudi Arabia in Group A on June 14.

SPAIN and Manchester United midfielder Ander Herrera is keeping focused on winning trophies ahead of the 2018 World Cup.

"We are optimistic of fighting for every title this season," said Herrera, ahead of United's derby clash against Manchester City on Sunday.

City are leading the Premier League title race but now that United have a fully fit squad available Herrera warned: "It's great to have players back."

Paul Pogba, Zlatan Ibrahimovic, Marcos Rojo and Marouane Fellaini have returned to the fold after injury and Herrera said: "With them in the squad we are stronger."

Meanwhile Spain midfielder and World Cup winner Juan Mata has praised United teammate Marcus Rashford: "Marcus is something special - a great mentality - and great qualities," said Mata.

Liverpool host Everton at Anfield on Sunday with Toffees new boss Sam Allardyce chewing over his hopes after signing an 18-month contract at Goodison Park.

"I've taken over the reins to bring stability - I want to do much more - it's my job to get among the European places, the FA Cup final or League Cup final," said Allardyce.

ENGLAND'S 2018 World Cup hopes are alive and kicking with Manchester United ace Marcus Rashford ready to head for Russia for the Finals next summer.

"We are doing our best to go there with a real plan and intensity to try and win the tournament," said Rashford.

England have been drawn with Belgium, Tunisia and Panama in World Cup Group G with their opening game against Tunisia in Volgograd on June 18.

England meet Panama, playing in their first ever World Cup, in Novgorod on June 24, and play their final group match against top seeds Belgium in Kaliningrad on June 28.

Rashford, who has been in the England fold under three

managers in Gareth Southgate, Sam Allardyce and Roy Hodgson, said: "The players are gelling in a whole different way."

Southgate was appointed as England manager in November 2016, and Rashford, axed from England's squad by new Everton boss Allardyce, said: "The set-up, aim and vision of where we want to go is much better."

England appear to have a great chance of reaching the last 16 in the 2018 World Cup and Rashford, 20, said: "We have to build our own plan once we get to the World Cup, to try and win it."

England qualified for the World Cup without losing a game in qualifying and Manchester United manager Jose Mourinho believes they go to Russia with hope.

"England must have a chance. There's a great generation of players at different ages and with different qualities," said Mourinho.

"They have good experience at club level, playing in the Premier League and in the Champions League. England have great potential," said Mourinho.

With the busy December schedule - United were in action against CSKA Moscow in the Champions League on Tuesday - and Rashford said: "It's great to have all the games. We take one game at a time."

United, who last won the Premier League title under Sir Alex Ferguson in 2013, finished sixth last season; winning the League Cup and Europa League under Mourinho.

United host arch rivals and Premier League leaders Manchester City on Sunday; Bournemouth on December 13; travel to West Brom on December 17 and play Bristol City in the League Cup quarter final on December 20.

"By the time it gets to Christmas, it calms down a bit. You start to see pathways - to certain tournaments - and trophies," said Rashford.

Rashford, who joined United's Academy aged seven, said: "You don't start to think about England until you start playing in the England youth team. That's when you start to dream about moments like this."

Rashford has been encouraged by England 1966 World Cup winning star and United legend Sir Bobby Charlton, 80, selected for four World Cups, who won 106 caps.

"Someone who has won it before - that's the biggest inspiration we can have as players," said Rashford.

Despite avoiding 2018 World Cup joint-favourites Brazil and Germany in the Group draw England boss Southgate was cautious.

"We've been good at writing teams off - and getting beat we're going to make sure we're prepared," said Southgate.
